There is a large amount of books missing from the library and unfortunately, if they are not returned the school is obliged to charge the parents for the replacement cost.

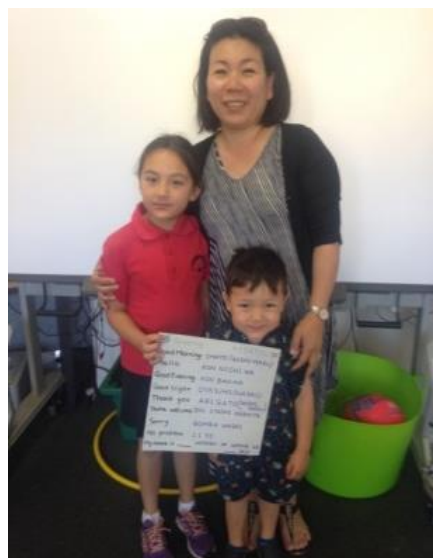
Please check very carefully at home, under the couch, under beds, in the public library book pile etc and return the books as soon as possible.
